ROBERTA GIGSTAD 4-H SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Due to the generosity of the Gigstad family, the Otoe County 4-H Foundation is offering one \$1500 scholarship to be given annually to a deserving high school senior who is currently an Otoe County 4-H member, either as a registered 4-H club member or as a registered 4-H independent member. This 4-H member must live in Otoe County and pursue a degree in either Veterinary Science or Family & Consumer Sciences.

- One (1) \$1500 scholarship will be given to an Otoe County 4-H member.
- The selected 4-H member will be chosen by a committee of Extension personnel from another county in Nebraska.
- The scholarship will be paid directly to the educational institution of the student's choice at the beginning of the second term of the recipient's post-secondary education. The 4-H member can attend an accredited two- or four-year trade school, college, university, or technical school.
- The scholarship application must be received by **January 1st** of the current school year and must be accompanied by one (1) letter of recommendation. Otoe County Extension personnel are ineligible to serve as a reference for this scholarship.

- The scholarship application will be evaluated on the following guidelines:

Experiences in 4-H projects and activities	75%
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Leadership Experiences in the Community	25%
